

- Note 7: Special Bench(s), if any constituted in addition to the Roster Benches, shall be convened in second half of the Friday.
- Note 8: If the listed matters related to personal liberties are not taken up for any reason in first half of the day in that event these matters shall be taken up by the concerned Benches at the beginning of the post lunch-session as per the convenience of the concerned roster bench.
- Note 9: First ten cases in the list before the Bench(s) shall not be ordinarily adjourned.
- Not 10: To ensure disposal of old cases pending up to the year 2002 in both the wings of the High Court, it is impressed upon both the Registrars Judicial to list 10 cases each before every Single Benches commencing from the week commencing 12thDecember, 2022. In the event these cases remain pending on the said date, same shall be kept on board till these cases are disposed of.
- Note 11: Declined matters of the Benches shall be listed before other available Roster Benches.

Note 12: The urgency memo may be placed to the senior-most Judge holding the Court singly as per Roster.
